NOTES:

- The **Year 11 and Year 12 exam block** is **WEDNESDAY 14 JUNE to FRIDAY 16 JUNE 2017.**

Monday 19 June is a normal school day for all Year 11 and 12 Students.

- **Some other tests will be /have been conducted in class before this period.**
- Students have received a timetable which indicates the location and time of the examination sessions. Students should go directly to the indicated room at **least 10 minutes prior to the start time of the session.**
- Each student should note the start time for each exam session. All students must present at the **beginning** of the session.
- It is the **student's responsibility** to sit for the exam at the **correct session** on the **correct day.**
- If students are sick and cannot sit for an exam they must produce a **doctor's certificate** and sit the exam as soon as they are well.
- Students are required to wear **full school uniform** during examinations.
- There will be **no form meeting** during the exam period.
- Students need only attend school if they have to sit for an exam or attend a scheduled catch up session **OR if they have outstanding assessment** and have been requested to attend to complete assessment by the **Head of Department or teacher.**
- **Students with outstanding assessment are to report to the library.**
- Students may remain at home to study during any free sessions and will be under parental supervision.
- Those students who attend school must be either in their exam room or a place arranged with a teacher for study or computer use.
- Parents who wish to send their student to school during this time should contact the school and a room for study will be made available.
- Students will be marked present when they attend an examination and absent on approved school activity when they are not present for an examination.

IN THE EXAMINATION ROOMS: STUDENTS

- Check the class list at the door. This will indicate your seat number for each session. Line up outside the hall door and wait for the supervisors tell you where to sit.
- Rolls will be marked at each session by the exam supervisors.
- All students enter the examination at the same time. If you have study time before your exam starts you may bring study material into the hall or exam room. All books, folders, pencil cases, etc. are to be placed on the floor before the exam starts.
- **No mobile telephones** are to be taken to the exam. Phones must be turned off and left in your bag.
- **Leave your bag in the place indicated by the supervisor** out of the room.
- All exams are scheduled to finish at the same time.
- **You will not be permitted to leave early unless your teacher has given permission for a specific purpose.**
- Once you enter the examination room, **silence is to be maintained.**
- If you are caught talking or cheating you risk the cancellation of your result.
- Ensure that you write your name and class on all sheets.
- Come prepared with what you need: paper, pens, pencils, rulers etc.
